Within fifteen (15) calendar days of receipt of this Notice Of Violation, the Respondent shall submit in writing, to the person issuing this Notice, details of how and when compliance will be achieved.

The issuance of this notice does not preclude the State of New Jersey or any of its agencies from initiating administrative and/or judicial enforcement action, or from assessing penalties with respect to the violations listed above or for any other violations.
